Our desire is to encourage the community to take full responsibility for the natural environment and to nurture and care for it on behalf of future generations.

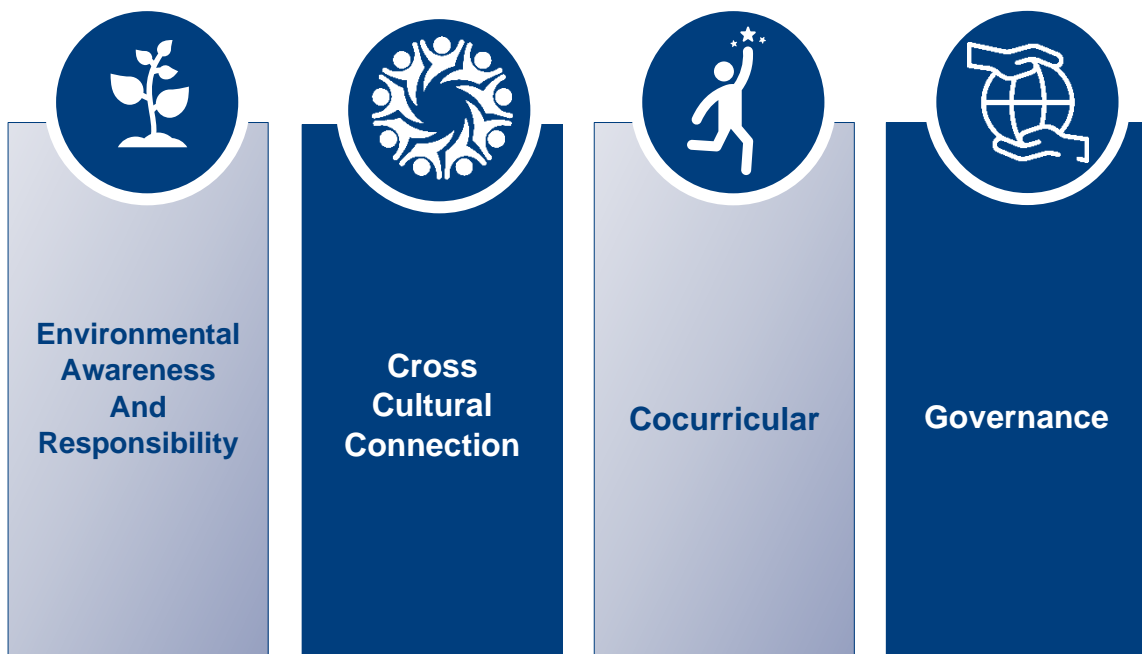
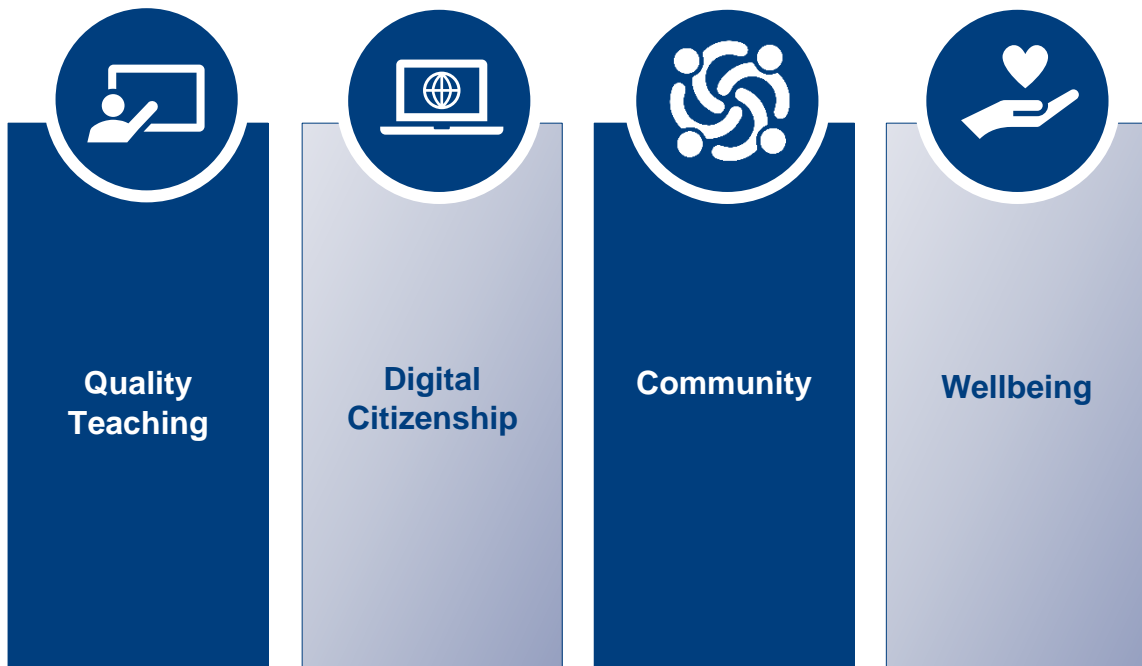
